SEPTEMBER 2026 YEAR 3 ADMISSIONS

Applications open Friday 7th November for you to apply for a Junior School place for September 2026. Please be aware that although we are a linked school, there is no automatic transition from Sandwich Infant School to Sandwich Junior School so all parents will need to apply for a place via the Kent County Council website.

HANDWRITING

At Sandwich Infant School, we use Little Wandle Handwriting for Reception as this ensures early development of fluent, legible handwriting and provides a structured approach to teaching handwriting. The programme has been carefully designed to support the development of legible and fluent handwriting using an easy-to-follow approach with consistent routines and memorable mantras.

By teaching handwriting right from the start, it means that children do not develop incorrect habits that are hard to break. Direct teaching of handwriting will prepare the children with the skills to develop fluent, speedy writing later on. We're pleased to say that Reception have started their discrete handwriting sessions.
