Absence from School in Term Time

Please do not request absence from school during term time as we are not able to authorise holidays or leave except in exceptional circumstances. Requests should be made on the form available from the office or the school website and submitted at least two weeks before the first date. If you remove your child without permission it will be recorded as unauthorised and could lead to a penalty notice being issued by Kent County Council. Medical appointments are obviously an exception.

Coats

As the weather starts to get colder please send a coat to school with your child. It is better to have a coat that spends all day hung on a peg than teachers trying to find a spare coat for a child because it is too cold outside. The children do play outside in light rain so a coat with a hood is preferable. Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled so they can be returned to the rightful owner as soon as possible.

Parking

If parents are dropping off or picking up from Fun Club, parents are able to use the school car park between 8.00am and 8.20am in the morning and after 4.00pm. Outside these times please be mindful of the school staff and our neighbours and do not block the roads around the school.

P.E.

P.E. is part of the national curriculum so all children are expected to take part. Children in Koalas, Lemurs and Swans need a full P.E. kit in school (shorts, T-shirt and plimsolls) throughout the term. The kit will be sent home at the end of each term to be washed. Earrings MUST be removed on P.E. days as they are a health and safety hazard. This takes precedence over the equality law (religious or cultural reasons). We do not accept children having their ears taped as an alternative to removing earrings.
